



AltaCima 4090 Merlot Reserva 2015

Composition: 85% Merlot, 15% Petit Verdot

D.O.: Lontué Valley (part of Curicó Valley)

Alcohol: 13.7° (Labeled as 13.5°)

Residual Sugar: 3,25 gr/lit

Total Acidity (H₂SO₄ - Sulfuric Acid): 3,45 gr/lit

Total Acidity (C₄H₆O₆ - Tartaric Acid): 5,29 gr/lit

Ageing: 7 months. 70% French oak barrels - 30% Stainless steel tanks

Tasting Note: AltaCima 4.090 refers to the height of the Peteroa Volcano that overlooks our vineyards from the Andes Mountains range. This Merlot has a deep ruby color, distinct flavors of cherries and raspberries and a delicious structure enveloped by sweet tannins.
